



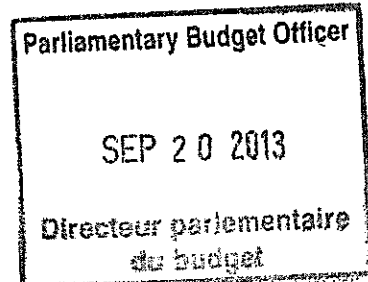

Dear M. Fréchette:

Thank you for your correspondence of September 9, 2013. Further to your request, I am writing to provide you with data pertaining to the proposed modernization of sick leave benefits at the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA).

Your letter requested that the Agency provide data for all leave codes for the past ten years. Enclosed is an excel spreadsheet containing the information you requested. For your information, in order to determine the average days per employee, the Agency used the number of individuals working or claiming leave in a given year. You will note that the Agency is only able to provide data from 2005-2006 onwards, as the CBSA only came into existence in December 2003, and was not initially distinct from the Canada Revenue Agency.
