



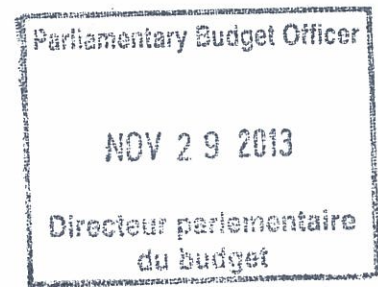

Finance Canada forecasts the ongoing liabilities for benefits and services offered to Veterans and released CAF members by Veterans Affairs Canada on the basis of the annual Actuarial Report on the Future Benefits for Veterans prepared by the Office of the Superintendent of Financial Institutions (OSFI) for the Office of the Comptroller General, which is shared with Finance Canada.
