Dear Mr. Giroux:

Thank you for your letter, dated December 7, 2022, requesting further information regarding employees in each of the public service staffing groups.

Please find enclosed tables from the pay system, listing population counts effective end March from 2016 to 2022, with a breakdown by classification group and level.

Please note that the classifications in separate agencies are not necessarily the same ones used in the core public administration (CPA), or in other separate agencies, even if they use the same codes. Each separate agency should be treated individually. Therefore, organization has been added to the separate agency table. Further, the information for separate agencies and the CPA are shown in separate tables.

During the reporting period, some classifications have been phased out or replaced with new classifications. Effective classification data provided is as shown in the pay system and is based on the effective classifications at that point in time.
