The Parliamentary Budget Officer (PBO) has been requested by the House of Commons Standing Committee on Finance to prepare a cost estimate of a private members' bill: Bill C-215 - *An Act to amend the Canadian Forces Superannuation Act and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Superannuation Act (deletion of deduction from annuity)*.

To fulfill this request, the PBO requires the following information from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP):

- Any cost estimates of Bill C-215, including:
 - The analytical framework used to prepare any cost estimates of the aforementioned private members' bill;
 - Supporting data used to construct the estimate (if individual-level data is provided, confidentiality will be respected);
 - A description of the key underlying assumptions used to construct the estimate
 - Any additional analysis undertaken by RCMP officials to construct the estimate that may be relevant (e.g., behavioural impacts associated with proposed changes)
 - Any recent valuations provided by the Office of the Superintendent of Financial Institutions (OSFI)
