Thank you for your correspondence of November 21, 2022, requesting information on additional funds that Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) has received through Budgets and fall economic statements.

Attached you will find a report providing details on the funding CIRNAC received either through Budget processes, fall economic statements, or off-cycle funding requests. As requested, this information is being provided for fiscal years 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

The information provided for fiscal year 2018-19 pertains to the former Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND), as CIRNAC was only created during the 2019-20 fiscal year. Note that we have only included information on the programs that now reside in CIRNAC, and excluded those under Indigenous Services Canada's responsibility.

Should you have any questions or require clarification as you draft your report, my departmental officials would be more than happy to assist you. In addition, we would also welcome the opportunity to review the final report before it is distributed.
