Thank you for your correspondence of February 13, 2017, requesting that Parks Canada provide various documents pursuant to section 79.3 of the *Parliament of Canada Act*.

Please find enclosed the completed reply form, as well as a zipped Excel file storing the data pertaining to the Canadian Register of Historic Places, dated February 28, 2017, in ".csv" format.

I should point out that not all field in the data extract, such as "Category of property," are mandatory, and therefore blank entries should be expected. When a single data field contains more than one entry, multiple lines are created for a single record. The *Canadian Register of Historic Places Documentation Standards Handbook* is also enclosed to help explain individual data fields and to provide definitions for the controlled vocabulary.

Furthermore, please note that as new listings are continuously being added to the Canadian Register of Historic Places, public disclosure should warrant a date stamp, for the sake of accuracy.
