Dear Mr. Haile:

I am writing in response to the recent request from the Parliamentary Budget Officer, to provide updated data for programs delivered by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) which obtained funding under Budget 2016's New Infrastructure Plan.

As requested, please find enclosed an updated table with project level funding data as at December 22, 2017, for Social Infrastructure Fund programs. Note that funding amounts per project represent cumulative totals since April 1, 2016, and exclude program and administrative level funding. For this reason, the list of projects funded will not equate to the total approved budget amount. As well, in some instances, the current template requests data that is either not applicable to CMHC's programs, or is not captured in our data systems. This has been reflected accordingly.

For funding delivered under the Investment in Affordable Housing (IAH), please note for project-level information, that not all projects have been publicly announced at this time. The Social Infrastructure Fund agreement is subject to the communication protocols noted in Schedule G and Clause g.1.3. of the IAH agreements, which indicate that all public information material in relation to the agreements must be prepared jointly.

Lastly, please note that CMHC does not receive project level information for Victims of Family Violence due to communication protocols arising from privacy concerns. For reporting requirements, CMHC tracks total funding for this initiative on a program level. The table below shows the cumulative funding results for the Victims of Family Violence and Shelter Enhancement Program at November 30, 2017.
