Dear Mr. Fréchette:

I am writing in response to your letter (information request IR0155) dated May 5, 2014, in which you requested information pertaining to Irving Shipbuilding Inc. and the Arctic/Offshore Patrol Ships project.

The Arctic/Offshore Patrol Ships project is currently in the definition phase. The implementation (or build) contract is expected to be awarded to Irving Shipbuilding Inc. in early 2015 with construction scheduled to commence later that year.

Public Works and Government Services Canada is not privy to the detailed information being sought and, as such, is unable to provide you with a fulsome response to your request. We can advise you, however, that Irving Shipbuilding has identified five (5) Tier One subcontractors (Lloyds Register Canada Ltd, Lockheed Martin Canada Inc., Odense Marine Technology, General Electric Energy Power Conversion and Fleetway Inc) for the Arctic/Offshore Patrol Ship project. Irving Shipbuilding is still in the process of determining its full supply chain for the construction of the ships and therefore the full number of its subcontractors and suppliers will not be determined until after the award of the above referenced implementation contract.

With regards to your detailed request, I would suggest that you contact Mr. Scott Jamieson, Vice President of Programs at Irving Shipbuilding Inc., who may be able to further assist you.
