Dear Mr. Giroux:

On behalf of the Honourable Steven Guilbeault, Minister of Environment and Climate Change, I am responding to your office's request of February 15, 2024 (IR0758).

Environment and Climate Change Canada will provide the following information regarding its modelling work undertaken for the Regulatory Impact Analysis Statement for the *Regulations Amending the Passenger Automobile and Light Truck Greenhouse Gas Emission Regulations*, which was published in the *Canada Gazette*, Part II, Volume 157, Number 26:

- The projected annual vehicle sales by vehicle type, by province, and for each of the following scenarios: Central case baseline, Central case policy, Alternative baseline, and Alternative policy.
- The annual average gasoline and diesel prices in dollars per litre, by province.
- The annual average electricity price in dollars per kilowatt-hour, by province.
- The total annual fuel costs for driving by type of vehicle, by province, and for each of the following scenarios: Central case baseline, Central case policy, Alternative baseline, and Alternative policy.
- The total annual electricity costs for driving by type of vehicle, by province, and for each of the following scenarios: Central case baseline, Central case policy, Alternative baseline, and Alternative policy.
- The projected annual incremental manufacturing costs, in dollars per vehicle, by vehicle type.
- The annual number of kilometres driven by vehicle type.

Your office requested additional information pertaining to total vehicle stock, maintenance costs, consumer prices, and government incentives. This information was not included in Environment and Climate Change Canada's modelling and analysis for the Regulatory Impact Analysis Statement published in Part II of the *Canada Gazette*, Volume 157, Number 26. As such, the Department does not have this information available.

Departmental officials have met with your office's analysts to explain what the Department is able to provide and to suggest alternative sources for the data it is unable to provide.

The data that Environment and Climate Change Canada is providing contains unpublished information. Therefore, please ensure that this information is used for your office's internal purposes only and that it is not published nor further distributed.

Should you require further clarification, the Department would be pleased to provide you with additional information.
