I am responding to your letter dated October 25, 2016, requesting access to departmental information concerning funding obtained via Budget 2016 dedicated to infrastructure spending.

As the department continues to work on allocating funds for year one either through calls for proposals or by amending existing agreements, project lists are not yet available for the First Nations and Inuit Child Care Initiative, the Homelessness Partnering Strategy, and the Enabling Accessibility Fund.

Please find enclosed information for the year two allocation (2017-18) in the amount of \$55.6 million in incremental funding, for the Homelessness Partnering Strategy, and the Enabling Accessibility Fund. As the First Nations and Inuit Child Care Initiative did not receive any social infrastructure Phase I funding for year two, no information is included in the table.
