Dear Mr. Giroux:

On behalf of the Honourable Seamus O'Regan Jr., Minister of Labour and Seniors, I am responding to your letter of November 9, 2023, in which you requested the following data for the years since the inception of the Canada Pension Plan (CPP) in 1966, or the first year available, up to the most recent year available:

- (1) historical contributions to the CPP by province and territory, age, sex and year;
and
- (2) historical CPP benefits attributable to contributions in each province and territory
by year.

Please find enclosed the requested data for part (1) and the reply form.

Employment and Social Development Canada is unable to provide the data requested in part (2). The administrative data does not attribute the benefits provided to individuals based on the province and territory where contributions were made. We have informed your staff to address the second question to the Office of the Chief Actuary, who may be better placed to respond.
