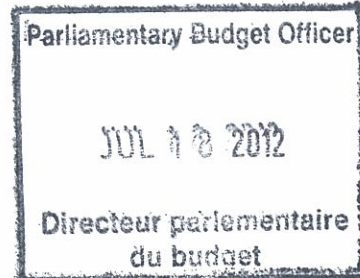

Dear Mr. Page:

This letter is in follow-up to my correspondence of December 20, 2011, relating to your analysis of Shared Services Canada's (SSC) longer-term cash flows anticipated from its transformation of email, data centres and networks.

As noted in Economic Action Plan 2012, in the first instance SSC will be achieving savings largely through consolidation to contribute \$150M to deficit reduction by 2014-15. Meeting this ambitious target is our first priority.

Additional savings will be achieved through the modernization of email, data centre and network services. As noted in SSC's *2012-13 Report on Plans and Priorities*, in this fiscal year, SSC will be working with its partners to identify an email solution for the Government of Canada. In addition, SSC will be developing a strategy for data centre consolidation and completing an initial inventory of networks and telecommunications by March 31, 2013. The projected cash flows associated with these initiatives will be established as this work is advanced.
