

This is in response to your letter of January 28, 2013, requesting “additional data records from the Central Financial Management Reporting System (CFMRS).” More specifically, you are requesting “the expenditures for Government-Wide Activity Code ISC\*, also known as “Internal Services”, delineated by *Standard Object, Reporting Object and Economic, Source and Class Objects*” for 2009–2010, 2010–2011 and 2011–2012 in Excel format.

The data provided excludes the detailed financial data for the legislative branch entities (i.e. the House of Commons, the Senate, the Library of Parliament, the Office of the Conflict of Interest and Ethics Commissioner and the Senate Ethics Officer).

In the future, the data will be provided to you on an annual basis once the Public Accounts of Canada have been publicly released.

While I am providing the data requested, I would encourage your office not to make any statements that would imply the Receiver General has participated in the analysis and/or supports any conclusions your office may derive from its use.
